



## Articulation and General Education Guidelines For Doctor of Pharmacy (PharmD) Program

### *Fullerton College to American University of Health Sciences*

Any course not listed in this agreement but that is designated as CSU or UC transferable in the **Fullerton College** catalog will transfer to AUHS as unit credit only. Only courses where a **grade of C or above** has been earned will be considered for transfer credit. AUHS will give credit for no more than 48 semester units or 72 quarter credit units of community college work. Please see AUHS current course catalog for additional transfer and admissions information.

#### Have you completed IGETC or CSU GE-Breadth Certification?

AUHS accepts the full IGETC and the CSU GE-Breadth Certification to satisfy the following requirements:

- Intellectual and Practical Skills (except Writing 3)
- Knowledge of Human Cultures and the Physical and Natural World
- Personal and Social Responsibility
- Philosophy from Biblical, Theological, and Philosophical Formation

**Please Note:** Certification must be completed four (4) weeks prior to the start of the PharmD program for Summer (Quarter) admissions. Prospective students are required to submit their application to the PharmD program on PharmCAS system for application consideration. AUHS will provide prospective students registered in PharmCAS with further information regarding PharmD program.
